About the Ships

NorthLink have three purpose built cruise ferries and one freight vessel. NorthLink charters additional freight vessels to meet peaks in demand for freight and livestock transport.

Sister ships MV Hjaltland and MV Hrossey operate the Aberdeen – Kirkwall – Lerwick routes while MV Hamnavoe operates the Scrabster – Stromness route. MV Hascosay serves the Aberdeen – Kirkwall – Lerwick freight routes.

MV Hjaltland and MV Hrossey each carry up to 600 passengers and 450 lane meters of cars and lorries. MV Hamnavoe carries up to 600 passengers and 400 lane meters of cars and lorries. MV Hascosay carries up to 420 meters of freight vehicles and up to 12 drivers.
